Here is the line-up and as always, there are 2 each of the first four wines (\*) and 1 each of the last four wines. \*Perrin 2022 Luberon Blanc, Rhone Valley, France (30% Bourboulenc, 30% Grenache, 30% Ugni blanc, 10% Roussanne) From southern France, this medium bodied savory dry white wine offers white flowers, citrus & subtle beeswax impressions. Well balanced in the mouth, it is fresh, with great vivacity & a hint of saltiness.

- \*Chateau La Periere 2022 Minervois Grande Cuvee, Languedoc-Roussillon, France (70% Syrah, 30% Grenache) Aromas of dark plum, blackberries and peppery spice. Fuller bodied, juicy and fresh finishing with lingering tannins. This is your burger and steak wine!
- ©\*Luzon Verde 2022 Monastrell, Jumilla, Spain- (100% Monastrell) An organic wine from Spain's Jumilla region. Friendly and juicy with ripe black berry and dusty notes on a nice tannic background. It is a very well balanced wine with a good offering of fruit, structure and spice. A lovely wine to pair with barbecue.
- \*Wool Pack 2022 Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand (100% Sauvignon blanc) Aromas of dried herbs, orange citrus blossom as well as the usual notes of grapefruit, gooseberry and fresh cut grass. Medium bodied with a nice balance between juiciness and minerality on the finish.

Cellier des Demoiselles 2022 Pinot Noir, Pays d'Oc, France- (100% Pinot Noir) Upfront red cherry notes and a silky texture characterize this super quaffable Pinot! Juicy on the palate with hints of smoke and earth finishing with soft refined tannins. A good match with Thanksgiving Turkey!

**Degani 2022 Valpolicella Classico, Veneto, Italy -** (40% Covina, 35% Rondinella, 25% Corvinone) Subtle earth and baking chocolate impressions mesh with dried cherry flavors in this medium-bodied, well balanced, velvety red wine from the Veneto region of northcentral Italy.

**Valle Martello 2022 Colline Teatine Cococciola "Brado," Gli Abruzzi, Italy-** (100% Cococciola) Used primarily in the past as a blending grape in Gli Abruzzi, this pure example of Cococciola offers apple and orchard fruit impressions in a lithe, bone-dry style. It is a multifaceted white wine, with great freshness, ideal as an aperitif, with sushi, fish dishes, first courses and cheeses.

Bestheim 2020 Riesling "Des Chasseurs de Lune," Alsace, France – (100% Riesling) This dryish Alsatian Riesling offers very expressive florl and lemon peel aromatics. There is a salty freshness and a long elegant finish. An excellent wine for accompanying the traditional Thanksgiving meal!

- **2016 Domaine Rolet Pere & Fils Arbois Trousseau, Jura, France-** (100% Trousseau) This is a traditional light red from Arbois which brings the complexity from the soils of the hills of Montigny and Arbois made of red marls and rich gravels. Light red in color with aromas of red fruits, cranberries and kirsch contrasted with notes of mushroom and tobacco. Light on the palate with good minerality and acid. Soft, plush tannins wrap around a core of red berry fruit, blood orange, rose petal, mint, wild flowers and lavender. Sensual and racy, with mind-blowing balance, the 2021 is magnificent. Bright saline accents linger on the explosives finish. The 80% whole clusters are pretty much buried. Don't miss it." (Galloni, Vinous 7/23) \$149.99

As you shop in the store you may see some wines displaying a green price sticker. This is our way of letting you know that the wine is organic, biodynamic, sustainable or natural. This is an ongoing process as we research each and every wine in the shop. Verbiage on the bottle may tell you more or you may ask us for further clarification. We are organized by place, not attribute, but as the wine world has made a healthy move toward better farming practices we needed to find a quick way to identify organic, biodynamic, sustainable and natural wines.

Consult with us on wines for your party or event and we will deliver directly to your home or office. Our regular deliveries will be made on Friday afternoons. There is no minimum order but there will be a delivery charge of \$10. Our regular service areas are zip codes 23226, 23229 and 23221

#### **RETURN POLICY**

J. Emerson, Inc. guarantees that each bottle of wine we sell is in good condition. If you purchase a bad bottle of wine from us, please bring the bottle (with wine) back promptly. We will taste the wine with you to try and ascertain what has gone wrong and we will replace the bad bottle with a good bottle of the same wine. We are not responsible for any damage that occurs after the wine has left the store. This is especially true in the summer. PLEASE do not leave your wine in your car or trunk. It takes less than two hours in 80-90 degree sun

to "pop" a cork. We will NOT accept any returns of warm or hot bottles. Returns should come back to us at about the same temperature as our store.

### **OUR PROTOCAL FOR USING WINE REVIEWS**

Throughout our newsletter you will find profiles of wine tastes and flavors written by professional wine reviewers. We use these reviews, when they align with our own tasting notes, because, frankly, these reviewers use descriptors and adjectives that are more interesting and often more on point than what we would write. When we use a reviewers notes we will always use quotes and we will always show attribution, i.e.: WA — Wine Advocate, WS- Wine Spectator, BH — Burghound and Vinous for... Vinous. Three of these review sources are reader subscription only and carry no advertising and they are: WA, Vinous and BH, and thus those are primary review sources. We will also occasionally use reviews from Decanter (the premier UK wine journal). Each review source also has reviewers that are better in some specialty then others. For example, Antonio Galoni has a wonderful sense of Italian wines and Allen Meadows of Burghound is a definitive source for the wines of Burgundy. The other key is that these reviews need to align with our tasting notes and if there is a huge discrepancy we will defer to our notes, which may be less interesting in terms of descriptors, but more in harmony with the wine profile. Our tasting notes would be any review without quotation marks.

### **OUR WINE ENVIRONMENT**

If you shop here you already know that we take the condition of the wine environment in the store very seriously. Wines are on their side, we monitor humidity and the temperature on the main floor never rises about 63 degrees. (In the winter we strive for 60.) We use no fluorescent lighting in the wine areas – THE WORST POSSIBLE LIGHTING CONDITION due to the high UV content. Instead we have been using indirect incandescent lighting. Now we are in the process of converting our lighting to LED, a source that produces NO UV light rays! Does your wine retailer care enough to take these quality control steps? Ask questions next time you are in a big box retailer.
